 Sec. TT-1. Calculations. Notwithstanding Part D of this Act, and notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15602, subsection 16 and section 15653, subsection 4, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part, the Department
 of Education shall make calculations of the distributions necessary to implement this Part and shall notify school units
 and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on Education and
 Cultural Affairs of these calculations.
