FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund 8 appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for the 2002-2003 biennium.

This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to 12 the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program by \$8,621,909 in fiscal year 2002-03 to hold 14 harmless local school administrative units at no less funding than they received in fiscal year 2001-02. This amendment also 16 increases General Fund appropriations to the Adult Education program by \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.

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This amendment also directs the transfer of \$16,621,909 from 20 the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

will amendment also increase This General Fund appropriations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and 24 Wildlife, Fisheries and Hatcheries Operations program by 26 \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. This amendment also increases General Fund appropriations to the Enforcement Operations - IFW program by \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. 28

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SUMMARY

This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program by \$8,621,909 in fiscal year 2002-03 to hold harmless local school administrative units at no less funding than they received in fiscal year 2001-02. This amendment also increases General Fund appropriations to the Adult Education program by \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.

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This amendment also directs the transfer of \$16,621,909 from 42 the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080

This amendment will also increase General Fund 2 appropriations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Fisheries and Hatcheries Operations program by 4 \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. This amendment also increases General Fund appropriations to the Enforcement Operations - IFW 6 program by \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.
