HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

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Amend the amendment in Part AA in section 9 in the 2nd line (page 154, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$3,200,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$3,600,000'

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Further amend the amendment by inserting after Part SS the following:

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PART TT

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Sec. TT-1. Calculations. Notwithstanding Part D of this Act, and notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15602, subsection 16 and section 15653, subsection 4, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part, the Department of Education shall make calculations of the distributions necessary to implement this Part and shall notify school units and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs of these calculations.

10 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund
 12 appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained
 for the 2002-2003 biennium.

14 This amendment will have no net effect on the Fund for a
 16 Healthy Maine projected balance at the end of the 2002-2003
 biennium.

18 This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to
 20 the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local
 Schools program by \$611,518 in fiscal year 2002-03. This
 22 amendment also deappropriates \$211,518 in fiscal year 2002-03
 24 from the Community Family Planning program within the Department
 of Human Services and deallocates \$400,000 from the Fund for a
 26 Healthy Maine program which was allocated for Community Family
 Planning services. This amendment also increases the transfer
 28 from the Fund for a Healthy Maine to the unappropriated surplus
 of the General Fund by \$400,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.

30 **SUMMARY**

32 This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to
 34 the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local
 Schools program by \$611,518 in fiscal year 2002-03. This
 36 amendment also deappropriates \$211,518 in fiscal year 2002-03
 38 from the Community Family Planning program within the Department
 of Human Services and deallocates \$400,000 from the Fund for a
 40 Healthy Maine program which was allocated for Community Family
 Planning services. This amendment also increases the transfer
 42 from the Fund for a Healthy Maine to the unappropriated surplus
 of the General Fund by \$400,000 in fiscal year 2002-03.
