HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part SS the following:

PART TT

Sec. TT-1. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on June 30, 2003 the State Controller shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the Maine Clean Election Fund in the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

Sec. TT-2. Calculations. Notwithstanding Part D of this Act, and notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15602, subsection 16 and section 15653, subsection 4, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part, the Department of Education shall make calculations of the distributions necessary to implement this Part and shall notify school units and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs of these calculations.

Sec. TT-3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.


