HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part SS the following:

PART TT

Sec. TT-1. Calculations. Notwithstanding Part D of this Act, and notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15602, subsection 16 and section 15653, subsection 4, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part, the Department of Education shall make calculations of the distributions necessary to implement this Part and shall notify school units and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs of these calculations.

Sec. TT-2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

**General Purpose Aid
for Local Schools**

Initiative: Provides additional funds over the funds appropriated in fiscal year 2002-03, of which \$3,000,000 is to be distributed through the funding formula and \$2,000,000 is to be distributed through a cushion.

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16 Initiative: Deappropriates funds to be distributed by the
17 Legislative Council. The Executive Director of the Legislative
18 Council must report to the State Budget Officer on the
19 reduction by line category and positions to be eliminated by
20 July 1, 2002. The State Budget Officer shall transfer the
21 calculated amounts by financial order upon approval by the
22 Governor. These transfers are considered adjustments to
23 appropriations in fiscal year 2002-03. The State Budget
24 Officer shall provide the joint standing committee of the
25 Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and
26 financial affairs a report of the transferred amounts no later
than January 15, 2003.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574,

2 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund
appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained
for the 2002-2003 biennium.

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6 This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to
the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local
Schools program by \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03, with
8 \$3,000,000 being distributed through the formula and \$2,000,000
being distributed as a cushion. This amendment also includes an
10 unallocated deappropriation of \$5,000,000 from the Legislature,
which is to be distributed by the Legislative Council.

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
