HOUSE AMENDMENT "\ \ " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for the 2002-2003 biennium. This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program by \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03, with \$3,000,000 being distributed through the formula and \$2,000,000 being distributed as a cushion. This amendment also includes an unallocated deappropriation of \$5,000,000 from the Legislature, which is to be distributed by the Legislative Council. SUMMARY This deappropriates \$5,000,000 amendment from the Legislature to be used to increase General Purpose Aid for Local Schools for fiscal year 2002-03, with \$3,000,000 distributed through the funding formula and \$2,000,000 distributed as a cushion.
