HOUSE AMENDMENT "N" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment in Part E in section 1 in subsection 1-U in the 6th line (page 123, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$86,600,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$91,600,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part GG in section 25 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the 7th line (page 183, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$5,100,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$10,100,000'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after Part SS the following:

PART TT

Sec. TT-1. Calculations. Notwithstanding Part D of this Act, and notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15602, subsection 16 and section 15653, subsection 4, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part, the Department of Education shall make calculations of the distributions necessary to implement this Part and shall notify school units and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs of these calculations.
