Notwithstanding Title 3, section 2, the salary for Legislators for the First Regular Session of the 121st Legislature may not be adjusted on December 1, 2002 by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index.

10	This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$25,614 in fiscal year 2002-03. Based on projections of
12	ending balances, a balanced budget is maintained for the 2002-2003 biennium.
14	This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to
16	the Department of Human Services by \$80,923 in fiscal year 2002-03 to provide a cost-of-living increase to residents in
18	nursing homes and residential care facilities.
20	It also includes Federal Expenditures Fund allocations to the department of \$31,877 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the federal
22	match.
24	This amendment also includes a deappropriation of \$55,309 in fiscal year 2002-03 from the Legislature due to the elimination
26	of the cost-of-living adjustment for Legislators pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2.

30	SUMMARY
32	This amendment requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules increasing the amount of income that may be retained
34	by residents of nursing and residential care facilities. This amendment funds the increase by funds that would otherwise go to
36	legislative cost-of-living salary adjustments.
