FISCAL NOTE

16 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained 18 for the 2002-2003 biennium.

This amendment will increase General Fund appropriations to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local
Schools program by \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 with \$5,000,000 being distributed through the funding formula and
\$4,000,000 being distributed as a cushion. This amendment also directs the transfer of \$9,000,000 from the Maine Learning
Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

SUMMARY

32 This amendment transfers \$9,000,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment and appropriates an additional \$5,000,000 to 34 General Purpose Aid for Local Schools and \$4,000,000 to the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools "cushion."
