SENATE AMENDMENT "*D*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1574, L.D. 2080, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment in Part D in section 20 in the 3rd line (page 122, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$5,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$12,384,730'

Further amend the amendment in Part GG in section 25 by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Transfers to the Retirement Allowance Fund pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1517, which may not exceed \$2,300,000; and'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after Part SS the following:

**PART TT**

**Sec. TT-1. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, Part 9, the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall transfer \$4,000,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the Maine Clean Election Fund no later than June 30, 2003.


**Sec. TT-2. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, Part 9, the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall transfer \$13,615,270 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the Maine Rainy Day Fund no later than June 30, 2003.

This amendment eliminates the Maine Learning Technology Endowment and instead funds a laptop program in the same manner that other state programs are funded by providing an appropriation of \$7,384,730 in fiscal year 2002-03. The amendment also provides \$4,000,000 to the Maine Clean Election Fund. The balance remaining from the elimination of the endowment, which is \$13,615,270, will be transferred to the Maine Rainy Day Fund.
