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**SUMMARY** 

The bill, as amended by the committee amendment, proposes amending the Constitution of Maine to establish different maximum property tax rates for different classes of property for the purpose of funding public education. In order to ensure that the future implementation of this provision is equitable and broadly supported, this amendment requires that any legislative measure that enacts a new tax or increases an existing tax requires an affirmative vote of 2/3 of all the members of the Legislature.
