HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1582, L.D. 2087, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Allow the Legislature to Establish Classes of Property for Purposes of Taxation and to Exempt Personal Property from Taxation if there is an Excise Tax on Certain Personal Property"

Amend the amendment by inserting after that part relating to Article IX, Section 8, Subsection 6 the following:

'Constitution, Art. IX, §24 is enacted to read:

Section 24. Allocations from reserve funds. Allocations from a reserve fund that sets aside funds for education or a dedicated reserve fund containing the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund require an affirmative vote of 2/3 of all the members elected to each House.'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the question in the last line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "grade 12" the following: 'and to provide that any money transferred from any reserve fund that sets aside funds for education and from any dedicated reserve fund containing the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund requires an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the members of each House of the Legislature'


