Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the question in the
last line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "grade 12" the following: 'and to provide that any
money transferred from any reserve fund that sets aside funds for education and from any dedicated reserve fund containing the
unappropriated surplus of the General Fund requires an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the members of each House of the
