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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1600, L.D. 2101, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Minority Recommendations of the Committee to Study Issues Concerning Changes to the Traditional Uses of Maine Forests and Lands"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§6048." in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 2, lines 13 and 14 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Within one year from the effective date of this section, each" and inserting in its place the following: 'Each'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the requirement in Committee Amendment "A" that requires all leases to comply within one year with the requirement that the lessee be given the right of first refusal.
