COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1608, L.D. 2106, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Administration of Medicine in the School Setting, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Administration of Medication in the School Setting, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 22 and 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "of portions of Administration of Medicine" and inserting in its place the following: 'of Administration of Medication'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The implementation of rules requiring local school units to prepare written local policy and implement training for all unlicensed school personnel who administer medication to students represents a state mandate, which has been exempted pursuant to Public Law 1999, chapter 669.

2 The implementation of rules pertaining to the administration
of medication in public or approved private schools, including
4 the training of unlicensed personnel to administer medication,
