COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1608, L.D. 2106, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Administration of Medicine in the School Setting, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Administration of Medication in the School Setting, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "is" the following: 'not'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It instructs the Department of Education not to authorize the provisional rule, Administration of Medication in the School Setting, a major substantive rule of the Department of Education. It gives the resolve a new title.
