COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1615, L.D. 2114, Bill, "An Act to Provide Full Utility of Retired School Buildings"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 1, lines 20 to 25 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'C. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the receiving town or towns may use the building for municipal purposes.'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the original bill by striking out references to the condition of the school building being transferred to a municipality and deletes references to limits on the nature of the work that could be done to the building by a receiving municipality.
