COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "/ to H.P. 1617, L.D. 2116

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1890-K.</u>" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 5, lines 35 to 38) and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>C. The President of the Maine Science and Technology</u> Foundation or the President's designee;

D. One member, or the member's designee, who is responsible for overseeing GIS functions of a state department that is a data custodian of geographic information, appointed by the Governor;'

14 Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§1890-K.</u>" in subsection 2 in the last blocked paragraph in the 16 first, 3rd, 5th and 6th lines (page 6, lines 32, 34, 36 and 37 lines in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>D</u>" and inserting 18 in its place the following: '<u>E</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1890-K.</u>" in subsection 2 in the last blocked paragraph in the 8th line (page 6, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>E and F</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>F and G</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1890-K.</u>" in subsection 2 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

30 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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## **'FISCAL NOTE**

36 This bill gives the Maine Public Library of Geographic Information Board authority to set standards for the form in 38 which electronic data will be stored. If these standards are not fully integrated with the Maine Info Net standards currently in 40 use, the University of Maine could incur significant costs to convert data into a format compatible with Department of 42 Administrative and Financial Services' Information Services Policy Board standards. The amount can not be determined at this 44 time.

 The University of Maine System, the Maine Science and Technology Foundation and the Department of Administrative and
Financial Services will incur some minor additional costs to serve on the Maine Public Library of Geographic Information

Board. These costs can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the system, the foundation and the department.

4 The additional costs associated with staff support to and expenses of the Maine Public Library of Geographic Information Board can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and 6 Financial Services' Bureau of Information Services utilizing 8 existing budgeted resources.'

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## SUMMARY

amendment requires the Maine Public Library of This Geographic Information Board to function in accordance with the 14 Maine Administrative Procedure Act. It adds as a purpose or duty 16 of the board to develop appropriate internal services to facilitate access for and use of data by government agencies and 18 the public. It also provides that the library may not compete directly with private enterprise. It also replaces one member of 20 the board who is responsible for overseeing GIS functions of a state department with the President of the Maine Science and 22 Technology Foundation.

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The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
