HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1619, L.D. 2118, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Committee to Study the Loss of Commercial Fishing Waterfront Access and Other Economic Development Issues Affecting Commercial Fishing"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:


FISCAL NOTE

The State Planning Office within the Executive Department and the Department of Marine Resources will incur some minor additional costs to convene a certain working group and to submit required reports to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to participate in a working group pertaining to water access issues. These costs can be absorbed within the departments' existing budgeted resources.'
