COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1627, L.D. 2127, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 4: Installation Standards, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 20 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause (page 1, lines 29 and 30 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The implementation of certain rules pertaining to the Plumbers' Examining Board adopting the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials Uniform Plumbing Code, 2000 edition, State of Maine Internal Plumbing Code as the standard for plumbing installations in the State of Maine will result in minor additional costs to the board. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause and adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
