HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1628, L.D. 2128, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$15,000,000 to Capitalize the School Revolving Renovation Fund for Repairs and Improvements in Public School Facilities to Address Health, Safety and Compliance Deficiencies; General Renovation Needs; and Learning Space Upgrades"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 in that part designated "~~S2463-A.~~" in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph D and inserting in its place the following:

'D. "Public educational institution" means the University of Maine System and the Maine Technical College System.'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 5 in the last line (page 4, line 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and the Finance Authority of Maine" and inserting in its place the following: 'the Trustees of the University of Maine System; and the Trustees of the Maine Technical College System'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 6 by striking out all of the last 7 lines (page 5, lines 29 to 36 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

Provides funding for public educational institutions for the purchase and installation of automatic sprinkler systems in dormitories. \$1,193,000

UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM


FISCAL NOTE

The amendments to the bond issue amounts net to zero, therefore, there is no impact to the General Fund.

The additional costs associated with administration of additional proceeds from this amendment to a certain bond issue can be absorbed by the University of Maine System and the Maine Technical College System utilizing existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the bond issue proceeds for the sprinkler system will inure to the University of Maine System and the Maine Technical College System.
