"Do you favor a \$35,900,000 bond issue to capitalize the State's School Revolving Renovation Fund for repairs and improvements in public school facilities to address health, safety and compliance deficiencies, general renovation needs and learning space upgrades and to provide grants to public educational institutions to install sprinkler systems in dormitories and, if incidental to such installation, to comply with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and to build a new correctional center in Machias?"

44 FISCAL NOTE

The amendment adds an item to the referendum question offered to the voters. If approved by the voters, the increased cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$17,401,410 with principal payments of \$13,900,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,501,410.
