SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 785, L.D. 2130, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$31,150,000 to Stimulate Job Growth in Maine"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$47,530,000 to Stimulate Job Growth in Maine, to Make Improvements to the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham and to Provide a Center for Homeless Teenagers'

Further amend the amendment in the Preamble in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "County;" the following: 'to make improvements to the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham;'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 1 in the 6th line (page 5, line 22 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "infrastructure;" the following: '**to make improvements to the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham;**'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 1 in the 13th line (page 5, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$20,930,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$32,030,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 1 in the 18th line (page 5, line 34 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "infrastructure;" the following: 'to make improvements to the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham;'

2 Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 5 in the
3 2nd line from the end (page 6, line 26 in amendment) by inserting
4 after the following: "System" the following: ', the
5 Commissioner of Corrections'

8 4th line (page 8, line 5 in amendment) the following:

10 **'CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF**

12 Provides funds to construct an \$11,100,000
13 infirmary and extended care unit for
14 special needs prisoners, to modernize
15 existing buildings and to enhance
16 security at the Maine Correctional
17 Center in South Windham in order to
18 meet current and future medical
19 needs of the prisoner population;
20 support treatment programs for health
21 care, substance abuse and sex offenders;
22 and improve intake and reception.'

24 Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 6 in the
25 last line (page 8, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the
26 following: "\$20,930,000" and inserting in its place the
27 following: '\$32,030,000'

29 Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 10 in the
30 question in the first line (page 9, line 21 in amendment) by
31 striking out the following: "\$20,930,000" and inserting in its
32 place the following: '\$32,030,000'

34 Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 10 by
35 inserting after subsection 5 the following:

37 '6. Funds of \$11,100,000 to make improvements to the Maine
38 Correctional Center in South Windham;'

40 Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 10 by
41 renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

44 **FISCAL NOTE**

46 The amendment adds an item to the referendum question
47 offered to the voters. If approved by the voters, the increased
48 cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$13,896,090 with
49 principal payments of \$11,100,000 and interest payments of
50 approximately \$2,796,090.

SUMMARY


