2 **Sec. 1. Purchase land. Resolved:** That the State, by and
through the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial
4 Services, is authorized to purchase property in the Town of
Machias, consisting of up to 46 acres, more or less, for the new
6 Downeast Correctional Facility. The property is located at the
Machias Industrial Park and includes approximately 25 acres of
adjoining acreage and an access road; and be it further

This resolve is reported from the Joint Standing Committee
16 on State and Local Government pursuant to Joint Order 2001, H.P.
1598. The resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Administrative
