COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1633, L.D. 2136, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Amendments to Chapter 127, Instructional Program, Assessment and Diploma Requirements, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Adoption not authorized. Resolved: That final adoption of Amendments to Chapter 127: Instructional Program, Assessment and Diploma Requirements, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule of the Department of Education, that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A is not authorized.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The committee amendment strikes and replaces the resolve with language to indicate that the "final adoption" of the "provisionally adopted" rule is not authorized.
