HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1637, L.D. 2140, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 296: Patient Brochure and Poster on Dental Amalgam and Alternatives, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Human Services"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Maine Rainy Day Fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'Fund for a Healthy Maine'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 8th line (page 2, line 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Maine Rainy Day Fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'unallocated funds within the Fund for a Healthy Maine'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Maine Rainy Day Fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'Fund for a Healthy Maine'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.


FISCAL NOTE

This amendment changes the funding source in Committee
Amendment "A" from the Maine Rainy Day Fund to the Fund for a
Healthy Maine. Transferring \$50,000 from the Fund for a Healthy
Maine in fiscal year 2001-02 reduces the balance available in the
fund by \$50,000.

The amendment includes an Other Special Revenue funds
allocation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Board of
Dental Examiners within the Department of Professional and
Financial Regulation to print and distribute a brochure and
poster on dental amalgam and alternatives.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the funding source for the brochure
and poster from the Maine Rainy Day Fund to the Fund for a
Healthy Maine.
