SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1637, L.D. 2140, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 296: Patient Brochure and Poster on Dental Amalgam and Alternatives, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Human Services"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'

Further amend the amendment in the first line after the title (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 3 and 4 and inserting in their place the following:

**'Sec. 3. Production and distribution of materials. Resolved:** That the Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services shall print and distribute the brochure and poster authorized by this resolve; and be it further

**Sec. 4. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding any provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$49,962 from the Nursing Facilities Other Special Revenue program within the Department of Human Services to General Fund unappropriated surplus no later than June 30, 2003; and be it further


