This amendment modifies the requirements for printing and distribution of the brochure and poster. It requires that the Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services distribute a copy of the brochure and poster to each dentist in the State and requires the bureau to make a copy of the brochure suitable for downloading and printing available on its publicly accessible site on the Internet.
