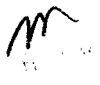

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 791, L.D. 2143, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Local Governance of School Administrative Units"

Amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 10-A in the 3rd line (page 2, line 1 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "materials" the following: 'and may approve educational materials'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill amends certain provisions of the education statutes to clarify the respective roles and responsibilities of school board members and school superintendents in governing and administering local school administrative units. The bill would result in no fiscal impact to the Department of Education or local school administrative units.'

SUMMARY

This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment proposes one change to the bill to clarify the duty of school board members in
