SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 793, L.D. 2146, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Maine Consumer Choice Health Plan"


Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~\$4346.~~" in subsection 5 in paragraph H in the first line (page 5, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~\$750,000~~" and inserting in its place the following: '\$700,000'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment would reduce from \$750,000 to \$700,000 the cap on funds used as a working capital advance for the initial operating expenses of the Maine Consumer Choice Health Plan. Because the timing and amount of any working capital advances to the plan will depend on decisions made by the board and its executive director, the impact of reducing the cap on these advances can not be estimated at the present time.

SUMMARY

The amendment reduces from \$750,000 to \$700,000 the cap on funds used as a working capital advance for the initial operating expenses of the Maine Consumer Choice Health Plan.
