HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1656, L.D. 2164, Bill, "An Act to Provide Government with the Necessary Authority to Respond to a Public Health Emergency Caused by an Act of Bioterrorism"

Amend the amendment in Part B in section 4 in subsection 3 in the next to last line (page 4, line 44 in amendment) by striking out the following: "routine technical" and inserting in its place the following: 'major substantive'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that rules adopted by the Department of Human Services to carry out its duties as specified in the laws governing the control of communicable diseases are major substantive rules rather than routine technical rules.
