SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1659, L.D. 2165, "Resolve, to Allow Julie Harrington to Sue the State"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 2nd indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "action." the following: 'The Department of Corrections shall, within existing resources, provide support in defending the claim.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$30,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. The ability of the Department of Corrections to absorb these costs can not be determined at this time.

This amendment requires the Department of Corrections to provide, within its existing resources, support in defending the claim.
