R. of S. COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1664, L.D. 2169

Further amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in the 4th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "28th" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>14th</u>'

SUMMARY

The amendment amends the accelerated reporting schedule for 14 traditionally funded candidates who have received or spent 101% of the amount disbursed to their opponents who are financed by 16 the Maine Clean Election Act. As amended, the 42nd day report will reflect activity through the 44th day prior to election day, 18 the 21st day report will reflect activity through the 23rd day prior to election day and the 12th day report will reflect 20 activity through the 14th day prior to election day. The amendment also changes the date of the report requirement from 22 beginning on the 28th day prior to election day to begin the 14th day prior to election day.
