COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1665, L.D. 2170, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Maine Citizens in Recovery from Drug Addiction Equal Access to Public Assistance"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The Bureau of Family Independence within the Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to provide public assistance to individuals who have been convicted of drug-related felonies. These costs can be absorbed within the department's budgeted resources.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
