SENATE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 810, L.D. 2175, Bill, "An Act to Amend the County Jail Prisoner Support and Community Corrections Fund"

Amend the bill in section 5 by striking out all of the first line (page 2, line 33 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 34-A MRSA §1210-A, sub-§§9 and 10 are enacted to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 9 in the 7th line (page 2, line 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "All" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in subsection 10, all'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 9 in the 10th line (page 2, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "All" and inserting in its place the following: 'Except as provided in subsection 10, all'

Further amend the bill in section 5 by inserting at the end the following:

'10. Implementation. The first \$23,658 collected under subsection 9 after the effective date of this subsection must be transferred to the Judicial Department to cover the costs of implementing the collection of surcharges.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 8 Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**County Jail Prisoner Support
and Community Corrections Fund**

Initiative: Allocates funds to be distributed to certain counties who experience at least a 10% increase in their annual jail operating budgets. The dedicated revenue to support this allocation is derived from a 1% surcharge on all fines, forfeitures or penalties imposed by any court in the State.

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FISCAL NOTE

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10 This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by
12 \$23,658 in fiscal year 2002-03. It includes an Other Special
14 Revenue funds allocation of \$23,658 in fiscal year 2002-03 for
16 the Judicial Department to support one-time costs out of the
revenue derived by the new surcharge. It also decreases the
Other Special Revenue funds allocation to the Department of
Corrections by the amount made available to the Judicial
Department.

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SUMMARY

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22 This amendment requires that the first \$23,658 collected
24 under the provision imposing the surcharge be transferred to the
Judicial Department to cover the costs of implementing the
collection of surcharges.
