If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the task force requires staffing 32 assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for 34 staff services. 36 The additional costs associated with serving on the task force can be absorbed by the Department of Environmental 38 Protection, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the State Planning Office within the Executive Department and the Department of Economic and Community Development utilizing 40 existing budgeted resources.' 42 44 SUMMARY 46 This amendment reduces the number of members on the Task Force to Study the Effectiveness of Stormwater Management in Developed Watersheds and removes the emergency preamble and 48 emergency clause. It also adds an appropriations and allocations 50 section and a fiscal note.
