Each additional referendum costs an additional \$8,000. 32 If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$18,778,500 with principal payments of 34 \$15,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,778,500. 36 The additional costs associated with administration of the proceeds of this bond issue can be absorbed by the Department of 38 Administrative and Financial Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 40 **SUMMARY** 42 44 This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill. 46
