The director's duties must be performed independently but under the general policy direction of the committee.'

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42 SUMMARY

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This amendment provides for the establishment of the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability as included in the bill, but provides that the Government Oversight Committee, the committee that oversees the work of the office, is a joint committee of the Legislature established under Joint Rules of the Legislature. The joint rules will establish the membership of the committee and the how the chairs are selected. This amendment makes technical changes to carry out those changes.
