SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1700, L.D. 2200, "Resolve, to Study the Impact of a Maine-based Casino on the Economy, Transportation Infrastructure, State Revenues and the Job Market"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection 6 in the last line (page 2, line 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"


Further amend the amendment on page 2 in the 2nd subsection 7 in the last line (page 2, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "be it further"

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the 2nd subsection 7 the following:

'8. Compare the costs, revenue and social implications of the proposed Maine-based casino with the expansion of gaming at commercial harness racing tracks; and be it further'
