SENATE AMENDMENT *A* " to S.P. 825, L.D. 2205, "Resolve, to Adjust the Valuation of St. John Plantation as a Result of a Fire"


Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$9,480,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$10,630,000'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment will decrease the reduction to the 2002 state valuation for St. John Plantation by \$1,150,000 from \$9,480,000 to \$10,630,000. This action reduces the increase in General Purpose Aid for Local Schools required for St. John Plantation in fiscal year 2002-03 and reduces the decrease of taxes redistributed in Aroostook County.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides the appropriate reduced valuation of \$10,630,000.
