HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1746, L.D. 2220, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part RR the following:

**PART SS**

**Sec. SS-1. Statewide curtailment of General Fund expenditures in fiscal year 2002-03.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Budget Officer shall transfer by financial order upon the approval of the Governor the amounts identified in section 2 of this Part. The State Budget Officer shall provide the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs a report of the transferred amount no later than January 15, 2003. These transfers are considered adjustments to appropriations in fiscal year 2002-03.

**Sec. SS-2. Supplemental appropriations and allocations.** There are appropriated and allocated from various funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, to the departments listed, the following sums.

**Departments and Agencies - Statewide 0016**

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Initiative: Deappropriates funds resulting from additional reductions of fiscal year 2002-03 expenditures from departments and agencies statewide.


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill in fiscal year 2002-03 by \$484,384,522 by implementing a statewide deappropriation to be distributed by financial order. The impact on state agencies and programs can not be determined at this time.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment decreases state spending by an additional \$484,384,522. This amendment reduces General Fund appropriations to reflect the amount of the budget implemented in fiscal year 1996-97 adjusted for changes in the Consumer Price Index since that time and further adjusted for amounts that are deappropriated elsewhere in Committee Amendment "A."
