Sec. SS-2. Transfer authority. Notwithstanding any other 16 provision of law, the State Budget Officer shall calculate and 18 distribute the unallocated amount in section 1 of this Part that applies against the Personal Services or All Other line category 20 within the Regional Operations program by financial order upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Behavioral and 22 Developmental Services and the approval of the Governor. These transfers are considered adjustments to appropriations in fiscal 24 year 2002-03.'
