18	Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of Joint Rule 303 and inserting in its place the following:
20	and inducting in 100 place the following.
22	'Rule 303. Committee Clerks.
24	1. Until February 1, 2001, the hiring of all committee clerks must be mutually agreeable to both the Senate and House chairs. If not agreeable to both, the President of the Senate
26	and the Speaker of the House shall decide. Until February 1, 2001, committee clerks serve at the pleasure of the President of
28	the Senate and the Speaker of the House.
30	2. Beginning February 1, 2001, committee clerks must be hired by the Legislative Information Office under the authority
32	of the Legislative Council. On February 1, 2001, committee clerks hired under section 1 become employees within the
34	Legislative Information Office under the authority of the
36	Legislative Council. Vacancies in positions originally filled under section 1 must be filled in accordance with this section.
38	3. Employment of the committee clerks terminates no later than the end of session.'

## SUMMARY

This amendment requires that beginning February 1, 2001, committee clerks be hired by the Legislative Information Office under the authority of the Legislative Council, rather than by committee chairs. Committee clerks hired by committee chairs prior to February 1, 2001 become employees within the Legislative Information Office on that date.
