HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 647, "Joint Order, Requiring the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs to Report out L.D. 1090 to the Senate"

Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of the indented paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs report out to the Senate, or return to the Senate, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Requirement that School Employees be Fingerprinted," S.P. 322, L.D. 1090.'
