SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The bill extended the 8 time for a licensed insurance producer to pay return premiums to an insured from 10 days to 45 days. This amendment extends that 10 time from 10 to 30 days. The amendment also clarifies that the payment of premiums by an insurance producer to an insurance 12 company must be done in accordance with the contract between the producer and the insurance company.

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
