COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 26, L.D. 19, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 130: Implementation of the State Purchasing Code of Conduct for Suppliers of Apparel, Footwear and Textiles, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Administrative and Financial Services"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "authorized." and inserting in its place the following: 'authorized only if the rules are amended as follows:

1. The rules must be amended to include at the end of the Bidding Procedures section the following: The names and addresses of suppliers at point of assembly may be kept confidential and not open for public inspection if the State Purchasing Agent determines the bidder has a program of monitoring that certifies its suppliers comply with the state purchasing code of conduct.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report and requires the addition at the end of the Bidding Procedures section a sentence indicating that names and addresses of suppliers at point of assembly may be kept confidential and not open for public inspection if the State Purchasing Agent determines the bidder has a program of monitoring that certifies its suppliers comply with the state purchasing code of conduct.
