HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 63, L.D. 55, Bill, "An Act to Keep Foster Children Safe and Healthy"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1580-E.~~" by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 1, lines 7 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Residence prohibition. A foster parent is prohibited from smoking, as defined in section 1580-B, subsection 1, paragraph B, in that foster parent's private residence if that residence is a family foster home, as defined in section 8101, subsection 3, when a foster child is present in that residence and may not allow any other person to smoke in that foster parent's private residence when a foster child is present in that residence.'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 4 in the 4th line from the end (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "home" the following: 'while a foster child is present in that home'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits a foster parent from smoking in that foster parent's private residence if that residence is a family foster home when a foster child is present in that residence and may not allow any other person to smoke in that foster parent's private residence when a foster child is present in that residence.
