18 Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting in their 20 place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4087-A, as amended by PL 2003, c. 20, Pt. EEE, §1, is further amended to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated 26 "§4087-A." in subsection 4 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 46 to 48 in L.D.) and inserting in its 28 place the following:

 30 '4. Services. The program shall provide services directly or-under-contract. The first priority in the work of the program
32 and-any-contract-for-ombudsman-services must be case-specific advocacy services. Any work on systems improvements or lobbying
34 must be adjunctive to case-specific activities. The program may:'
