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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.' 8 SUMMARY

10 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause, which will immediately allow the State Fire Marshal and the State Fire Marshal's deputy and investigators to exercise their law enforcement powers for issues other than fire 14 prevention and arson.
