## An Act To Empower Anglers in Fish Stocking Decisions

2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7013-A, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 416, §1, is amended to read: 4 §7013-A. Fish stocking 6 8 1. Public comments. When the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Bureau of Resource Management determines 10 that there is a need to consider changing the long-term management objectives on a water or group of waters that-supports 12 a-major--fishery-or-major-fisheries, including a change in the species of fish stocked for experimental or any other purposes, 14 the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall provide

information regarding such a proposal to any person at that person's request. The bureau shall conduct department-sponsored meetings to solicit public comments on those management objectives.

20 2. Department-sponsored meetings. Regional fisheries biologists must be available at department-sponsored meetings 22 held pursuant to subsection 1 to review the management eppertunities--presented--by--the-proposals--to--change--leng-term 24 management-objectives,-as-well-as-the-information-used-to-assess the--opportunities, and stocking changes being considered, to 26 present the information used to make the determination that changes were necessary and to receive public comments concerning 28 the proposals.
